SIMPLE



Materials:

- Yarn Bee® Baby Bee, Angel Fleece (shown in Crayons), 5 oz. skeins of 127 yds
Main Color (MC) – 9 skeins 
- Yarn Bee®, Cameo Bulky (shown in Carnelian), 3 oz. skeins of 74 yds
Color 1 (CC) – 2 skeins 
- Yarn needle

Crochet Hook:

Size L-11 (8 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge.

Gauge: Each Square = 11"



SIZE: 52" WIDE X 68" LONG

Square: (Make 30)

Rnd 1 (right side): With MC ch 5, sl st in first ch to form a ring, ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), 15 dc in ring; join with a sl st to first dc (16 dc). Finish off.

Rnd 2: Join CC with a sl st in any dc, ch 1, sc in same st as joining and in each dc around; join with a sl st to first sc (16 sc). Finish off.

Rnd 3: Join MC with a sl st in any sc, ch 5 (counts as first dc, ch 2, now and throughout), 3 dc in same sc, ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 2, skip next sc, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next sc (first corner made), ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 2, rep from * twice more, 2 dc in same st as joining; join with a sl st to first dc. (24 dc, 4 sc and 12 ch-2 sps)

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, 3 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next 2 ch-2 sps, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 corner, 3 dc in next 2 ch-2 sps, rep from * twice more, 2 dc same sp as first sl st; join with a sl st to first dc (48 dc). Finish off.

Rnd 5: Join CC with a sl st in any ch-2 corner, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sp, * sc in each dc across to next ch-2 corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 corner, rep from * twice more; join with a sl st to first sc (56 sc).

Rnd 6: Join MC with a sl st in any sc after a ch-2 corner, ch 3, * dc in each sc across to next ch-2 corner, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 corner, rep from * 3 times more; join with a sl st to first dc (72 dc). Finish off leaving long end.

Assembly:

Sew squares together 5 wide x 6 high.

Edging:

With right side of afghan facing, join MC with a sl st in any ch-2 corner of afghan, ch 1, * (sc, ch 5, sc, ch 3) in ch-2 corner, (skip next dc, sc in next dc, ch 3) across to next corner, rep from * 3 times more; join with a sl st to first sc. Finish off and weave in ends.
