## Daisy Does It

Show guests to their seats with a lovely handmade chair accessory. Simply cut individual stems from a daisy bush, glue them to a length of burlap ribbon, and add a name tag. The burlap keeps it natural. The chalkboard sign keeps it trendy. The every-color daisies keep it quirky. And you keep it fresh and fabulous.




## Seeing Jars

Stunning floral centerpieces don't have to mean hours of arranging bunches of blooms—and they don't have to break the bank either. A few color-coordinated blooms (cut from daisy bushes) placed in wire-wrapped jars offer minimalist style that's right on trend.



## Fresh as a Daisy

This easy-does-it table runner will earn you major style points. We glued a row of daisies to each end of a burlap runner, but use as many or as few blooms as you like. *Design tip:* If your color scheme or theme calls for it, don't be afraid to try a monochromatic look.

## Have a Treat

Is there anything sweeter than a daisy-dotted treat box? We don't think so—unless you count the fact that they're easy-breezy to put together. Just grab a ready-to-give gift box, glue on a daisy and tie on a bow of jute. We can just hear the “oohs” and “ahhs” now.



## Upsy Daisy

Daisy-decked paper lanterns turn the awesome factor up a notch! We used low-temp hot glue to adhere cut-from-the-bush blooms to the lanterns and hung them at varying heights with jute. Now that we think of it, these floating lanterns would make a great photo backdrop too...

## Plate Bloomer

A DIY'ed napkin ring takes a basic birthday party (or bridal shower, brunch with the girls, Tuesday evening dinner... you get the idea) to a new level of all-out fun. To get this no-fuss look, plant a daisy bloom on a length of jute and tie the jute around a napkin.
