- D) 12x12: lace, self-adhesive pearls, paper, ampersand (pg. 4)

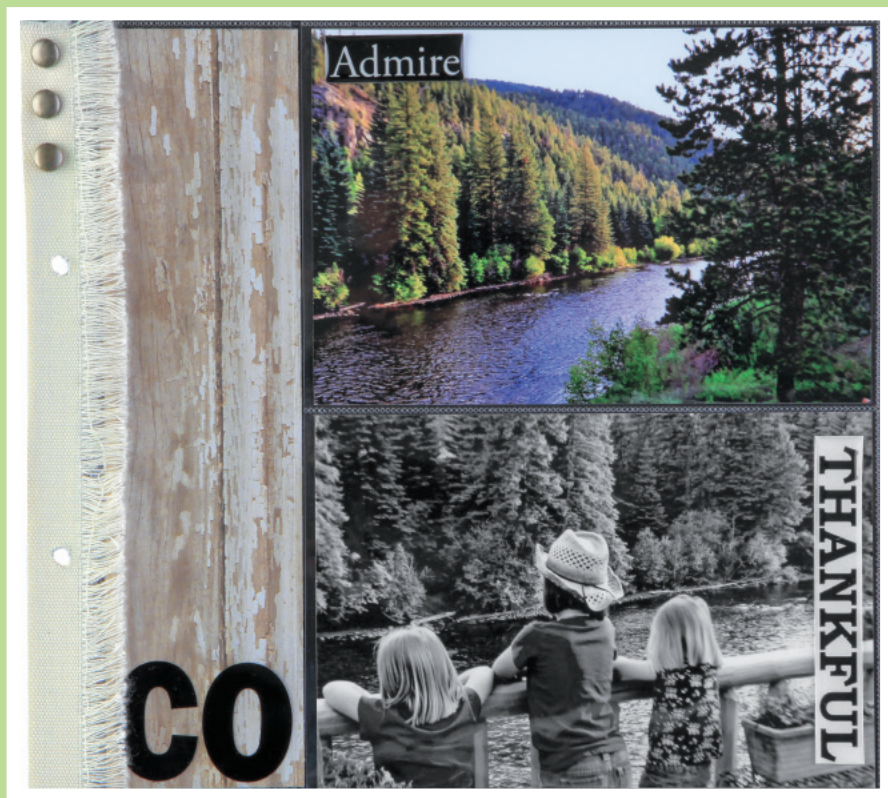
