SIMPLE



Size: Adult S-L, (1X, 3X)

Materials:

- Yarn Bee®, Effervesce (shown in Regency), 4 oz. skeins of 224 yds. – 2 skeins  Medium
- Yarn needle

Crochet Hook:

Size K-10 ½ (6.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge: 5 (dc, ch 1) and 6 rows = 4"

Abbreviations:

Beg – beginning

Dc – double crochet

Sk – skip

Ch – chain

Rep – repeat

Panel:

(Make 2)

Row 1: Ch 48 (58, 68), dc in 6th ch from hook, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) across [23 (28, 33) dc].

Next Row: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1, now and throughout), turn, dc in next dc, (ch 1, dc in next dc) across [23 (28, 33) dc].

Rep Next Row until panel measures 33" (37", 41") from the beg. Finish off, leaving long end.

Assembly:

Using Fig. 1 as a guide, and using long ends and yarn needle, sew panels together. Weave in ends.

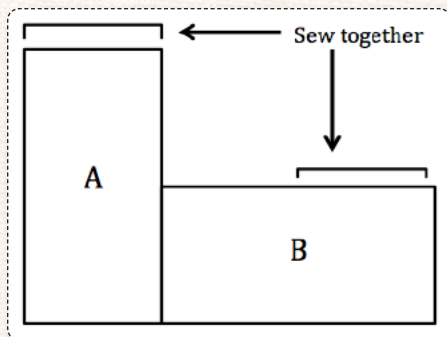
