HANDS DOWN TO YOUR FEET

These darling crochet accessories will keep 'em warm and toasty all winter long, check out these adorable patterns.



sweet tooth

SIMPLE



MATERIALS:

- Baby Bee® Sweet Delight (shown in Angel, Infant Teal and Baby Red)

Color 1 (A) - 2 skein

Color 2 (B) - 2 skein

Color 3 (C) - 1 skein



- Crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Embroidery thread
- Child's headband: 1 ½"-2" width
- Beads

CROCHET HOOK:

Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

9 rows of 16 dc = 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch – chain

Beg – beginning

Rep – Repeat

Sc – single crochet

Dc – double crochet

Sl st – slip stitch

Tr – treble crochet

Sctbl – single crochet through back loop

Sc2tog – single crochet two stitches together

BABYCAKES

Who says you can't have your cake and eat it too?

This precious cupcake headband and legwarmers are fit for a queen... a tiny queen, that is. And that means anything goes! So why not pair two cupcake crochet pieces on your little bundle of joy? She'll be so cute, you could eat her up.



BIG SIS EARMUFFS

SIZE: 20" from ear to ear

HEADBAND

With C, ch 20.

In 2nd ch from the hook, sc 18 across.

Ch 2, turn, sc 18 across.

Change to A.

Ch 2, turn, sc 18 across.

Ch 2, turn, sc 18 across.

Rep for 18 rows. Fasten off.

Sew sides together lengthwise to form a tube.

Slide headband into tube and sew ends shut.

EAR MUFFS (Make 2 of each circle)

Circle 1:

With B, ch 6; join with sl st.

2 sc in st around, sl st to join (12 sts).

(2 sc, sc) rep around (18 sts).

(2 sc, sc, sc) rep around (24 sts).

(2 sc, sc, sc, sc) rep around (30 sts).

(2 sc, sc, sc) rep to last 2 sts, 2 sc, sc in last; join with sl st (40 sts).

Fasten off (for Circle 1 only).

Circle 2:

Follow directions for circle 1. Then (sc, 3 tr, sc) in every other st around.

Circle 3:

Follow instructions for circle 1. Then (2 sc, sc, sc, sc) rep around.

(Sc, 3 tr, sc) rep around; join with sl st and fasten off.

HEART APPLIQUÉ

Crochet hook: F-5 (3.75 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

With C, ch 6, 3 tr in 2nd ch from hook, 3 DC in next, ch 1, tr, ch 1, 3 DC, 3 tr, sl st to center to form heart shape.

ASSEMBLY

Sew heart appliqué to right side of circle 1.

Sew circle 1 to circle 3.

Sandwich circle 3 and circle 2 on either side of one end of the headband. (Place circle 3 on the outside.) Using B, sew them together and to the headband.

Rep for the other side.



MUSIC TO MY EARS

Our confection-worthy earmuffs are sure to make a trendy fashion statement—but it gets better. They're practical, too! They'll keep those ears nice and warm without compromising even an ounce of the cute factor. Speaking of, we love that the striped band gives this piece a playful side. And the heart embellishments are the icing on the cake! Now that's a tune we can all sing to!



FRILLS THAT THRILL!

Our striped and frilly legwarmers are a hoot! And they go perfectly with a fuzzy boot. Who knew crochet could be so downright cute? Check out our pattern for the darling-est stockings around. Whether she's cutting a rug or cozied by the fire, you can be sure your little one looks as fabulous as she really is . . . because these fashion-forward warmers stand out!

BIG SIS LEG WARMERS (Make 2)

SIZE: 11" long and 10" circumference

STRIPES

With B, ch 33, join with sl st, careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, dc around, join with sl st in top of ch 2.

Rnds 2-19: Join A with sl st, ch 2, dc around; join with sl st in top of ch 2.

Alternate A and B every other row.

Bind off, and weave in ends.

CUPCAKE HOLDER

Using C, ch 13.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc across.

Rows 2-44: Ch 1, turn, sc2bl across.

After completing 44 rows (or desired length), sew short ends of ribbing together, creating a tube. Sl st cupcake holder to bottom of leg warmer.

ICING RUFFLES

Rnd 1: Using A, join with sl st into top of ribbed st (cupcake holder). Ch 3, work 44 dc into ribbed st around.

Rnds 2-3: Ch 3, 1 dc into same st, 2 dc into each st around; join with sl st at top of ch 3. Finish off and weave in ends.



A SHOW OF HANDS

Start with one crochet hook and two colors of yarn. Sprinkle a heap of colorful accents, as desired. Then comes the cherry on top, and ta-da! It's the perfect recipe for keeping those hands snug with style, all thanks to our darling fingerless gloves. And they're a piece of cake to make! Literally!

TREAT YOURSELF!

We paired bright red and blue yarn colors – with pops of white – to really make our patterns stand out! Dissimilar colors tend to help these designs pop, but choose whichever shades and hues suit you and your little ones!



BIG SIS HAND WARMERS (Make 2)

SIZE: 3" x 5"

CUPCAKE HOLDER (BOTTOM)

Row 1: With C, ch 12, sc in 2nd ch from hook and across (10).

Row 2: Ch 2, sc2bl across.

Rep Row 2 for 25 rows. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing at the end.

CUPCAKE ICING (TOP)

Row 1: With A, ch 29, in 2nd ch from hook sc across (27 sts). Ch 2.

Rows 2-6: Rep Row 1.

Row 7: (Sc, 3 tr, sc) in every other st.

Join bottom to top (*Note: Ribbing should be vertical on bottom and horizontal on top*). Turn glove inside out and sew up the sides with yarn needle and yarn, leaving room for thumb. Embellish top with bugle beads.

CUPCAKE CHERRY

Using C, ch 6; join to form circle. 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st.

Bind off, leaving a long tail to sew to top with yarn needle.

LIL' SIS HEADBAND

SIZE: 16" circumference

HEADBAND

Using B, ch 60. Join with sl st, careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc around.

Rnd 2: Join A with sl st, ch 1, sc around. Join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Join C with sl st, ch 2, dc around. Join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4: Join A with sl st, ch 1, sc around. Join with sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: Join B with sl st, ch 2, dc around. Join with sl st in beg ch. Fasten off, and weave in ends.

CUPCAKE APPLIQUÉ (BOTTOM)

Row 1: Using C, ch 8. Sc in 2nd ch from the hook, sc across.

Row 2-3: Ch 1, turn, sc2tbl across (7).

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc2tbl in first st, sc2tbl in the next 5 sts, 2 sc2tbl in last st (9).

Row 5: Ch 1, sc2tbl across (9). Fasten off.

CUPCAKE APPLIQUÉ (TOP)

Row 1: Using A, join with sl st, sl st across the top of cupcake appliqué (bottom). *Note: Bottom ribbing will be horizontal.*

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc across.

Row 3: Ch 2, turn, dc across.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog.

Row 6: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog.

Row 7: Turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog. Fasten off; sew on beads as desired to serve as sprinkles.

CUPCAKE APPLIQUÉ (CHERRY)

Using C, ch 2, 8 dc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st and bind off, leaving tail to sew to top of appliqué. Sew completed appliqué to headband.

LIL' SIS LEG WARMERS (Make 2)

SIZE: 6" long and 7.5" circumference

STRIPES

Using A, ch 32.

Starting in the 2nd ch from hook, sc across (30 sts).

Ch 2, sc across (30 sts).

Change to B, ch 2, sc 30 across.

Change to A, ch 2, sc 30 across.

Rep for 22 rows, making 26 total rows.

With sides facing together, join sides of piece with needle and yarn. Sew sides together, forming a tube.

APPLIQUÉ

Using C, ch 9, starting in the 2nd ch from hook, sc 7, ch 2.

Sc in the 1st st, sc 5, make increase in last st.

Join A in last st just made.

2 sc in first st, sc 7, 2 sc in last st, ch 2, turn.

2 sc in first st, sc 9, 2 sc in last st, ch 2, turn.

Sc across. Fasten off.

Use embroidery thread to add beads as desired. Embellish before attaching appliqué to legging. Attach to leg warmer with needle and thread.
