# Supplies:

- Glass jar
- Deer figurine
- Miniature cardinal
- Miniature Christmas tree
- Miniature tool set
- Foil Christmas stickers
- Designer tape
- Transparent tape
- Scrapbook paper (white and brown)
- Glitter (silver and clear)
- Casting resin
- White pigment
- E6000®
- Paper trimmer
- Adhesive dots
- Pencil
- Palette cup
- Ruler
- Cutters
- Scissors



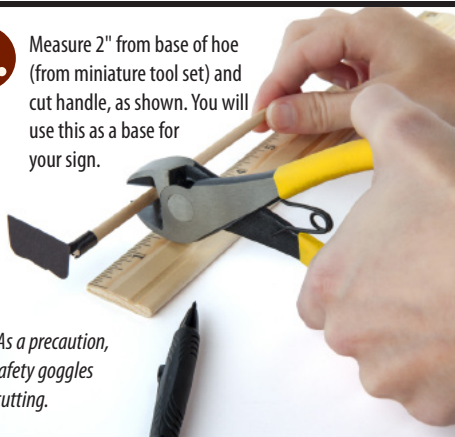
1.



To make sign, adhere desired sticker to white scrapbook paper; cut around it, leaving a 1/8" border. Adhere that to brown scrapbook paper with an adhesive dot. Cut around it, leaving a 1/8" border.

2.

Measure 2" from base of hoe (from miniature tool set) and cut handle, as shown. You will use this as a base for your sign.



*Note:* As a precaution, wear safety goggles while cutting.

3.

Use transparent tape to adhere wooden handle to back of sign. Then cover transparent tape with designer tape for a finished look.



4.

Adhere miniature cardinal to deer figurine with E6000®.



Apply a thin line of E6000® along top edge of sign, and sprinkle on clear glitter. Let deer and sign dry completely.

- 5.** *Note: This step will make the faux snow.* Following manufacturer's instructions, measure equal amounts (we used 20 ml) of both parts of casting resin into provided cups. Pour each into palette cup, and mix with provided stir stick. Then add glitter and a few drops of white pigment, and mix together.



- 6.** Slowly, and being careful to keep it from getting on sides of jar, pour resin mixture into glass jar.



Arrange Christmas tree, sign and deer into resin as desired. Hold pieces into place approximately 3-4 minutes, or until they'll stand on their own.
