Store-bought darlings like these are practically begging for some DIY embellishment. Here's our best idea: Add a few color-coordinating crystals and a pop of blue thread around the edge. Now you've got one jazzed-up scarf that's not afraid to show its wild side.

Here's a tip: When you're applying crystals to a patterned fabric, it's best to go with the flow. That way, the crystals enhance the existing design rather than detract from it.



### Grown JEWELS

Gorgeously glitzy décor? Coming right up. We used a crown-shaped stencil to get the right shape, and then we lined crystals along the stencil. We went with a single outline, but feel free to fill in the design—the more glimmer, the better! Try this technique on shirts, blankets, or anything that needs a quick bling-me-up.



#### All in your HEAD

When you pair the classic elegance of lace with the spunky sparkle of crystals, the result is simply stunning. To get this look, add colorful crystals to this off-the-shelf lace headband—and try out the heat-set tool for easy application.

# Cuffed UP

Draw your own design onto a swatch of cotton fabric, and fill it in with glittery crystals galore—we used triangles and rectangles to get the right shape. Then glue it all to a ready-made burlap cuff, and you've got super-shimmery style that's always on-hand.

# The right TOTE

To match our sparkle-meets-chic headpiece, we cut headbands and adhered them straight onto a burlap and canvas bag! We chose bright and colorful crystals (adhered according to the lace pattern) to amp up the neutrals.







Heaped-on gems give this bow tie an almost-mosaic effect. The trick? Multi-color, multi-shape crystals. We adhered them all to a DIY'ed felt bow tie. Then we used the finished product as a downright dapper accessory for our antlered wall art.



The key to an ultra-glam deer dude like this one is simple—a lotta shimmer and a little double-sided adhesive. We wrapped the antlers with strips of tape, and then placed the crystals in a stripey pattern. It's forest fashion to the max.
