- Iron and ironing board






TIPS & TRICKS:

- Trim Whim: If you're adding a trim that seems too thick for the sewing machine, you can secure it with fabric glue instead.
- Give 'Em an Inch: When making more than one shade for same-sized windows, be sure to write down your measurements the first time around. This will save lots of time on subsequent shades.
