KEEP IT CUSHY

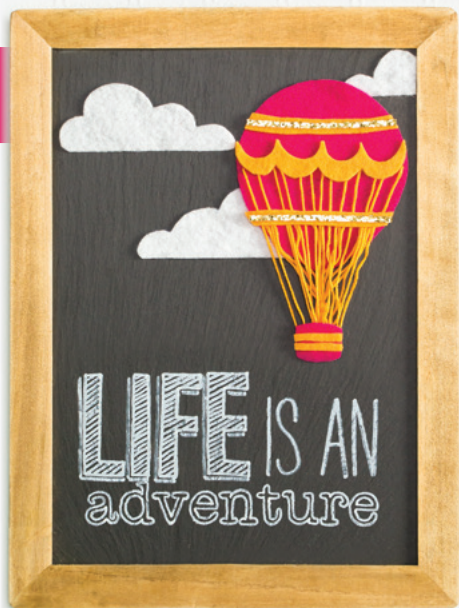
Try turning your favorite soft spot into a felt fest with piles of cute and crafty accent pillows.

On the right: bow-bedecked mini, made from four 9" x 12" sheets.

On the left: rows and rows of hand-cut felt half circles, stitched into place.

GOTTA FLY

How do you turn a humble slate chalkboard into art? Cut a hot air balloon from felt—it can be as simple as you want it to be—and make it fly with embroidery floss and glittered vinyl. Then write an uplifting message with a white paint pen.



WORLD VIEW

Picture this: simple felt cutouts, glued to a painted wooden plaque. It's an easy approach to wall décor, but it packs a wallop when it comes to make-you-smile style. We added some glittered vinyl (sold near the felt sheets) to this global design.

SIGN OF THE TIMES

If you don't have a gallery wall, you're missing out on a prime chance to deck your halls with felt. Try artful cutouts on wooden plaques or in brightly painted frames.

PATCH ME IN

Trade traditional quilt scraps for craft felt for a look that's bold, crisp and just plain happy-day inducing.

Pillow and blanket: Use 9" x 12" sheets for the herringbone patchwork pieces and mega 36" x 36" craft packs for the backs and borders.



GARDEN VARIETY

For a trendy touch on a wreath (or quirky addition to a bedside table), try your hand at your very own felt flower bouquet. Cut strips, circles, and loops for to start—then twist, bunch, wrap and glue to make an assortment of adorable freestyle blooms.



SUPPLIES:

- Square wooden plaque
- Acrylic paint
- Glitter vinyl
- Craft felt
- Water-soluble marker
- Felt glue
- Foam brush
- Paint cup
- Ruler
- Scissors



Note: For the letter, simply print out or draw your initial to the appropriate size. Then cut around it, and use it as a template.

INSTRUCTIONS:

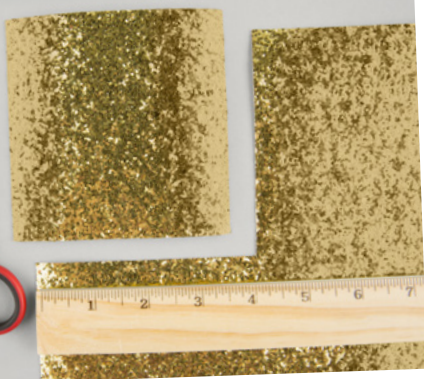
1

Paint wooden plaque, and let dry.



2

Measure and cut a square of glitter vinyl—it should completely cover the front of your plaque.



3

Adhere vinyl to plaque with felt glue.



4

Trace circle onto felt with water-soluble marker.



5

Adhere circle to vinyl.

6

Trace letter onto back of vinyl with water-soluble marker, and cut out.

Tip: Be sure letter is face down.



7

Adhere initial to center of felt circle.
