Egg Garland

Supplies:

- Ultra Thin Glue Dots®
- Cardstock
- Fishing line
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Cut 6 ovals out of cardstock and fold each oval in half vertically.
2. Generously apply Ultra Thin Glue Dots® to outside of the folded ovals.
3. Press ovals together side-by-side until they create a complete circle.
4. Repeat steps 1-3 until you have as many "eggs" as you want.
5. Tie a knot in fishing line and feed it through the center of an egg.
6. Knot fishing line again at the other end of the egg to keep it in place.
7. Leave a space and tie another knot to add another egg to garland.
8. Repeat steps 5-7 until all eggs have been added to fishing line.
9. Hang your garland and enjoy!

Wooden Eggs

Supplies:

- Mini Glue Dots®
- Craft Glue Dots®
- Micro Glue Dots®
- 1" Glue Lines®
- Continuous Glue Lines®
- Wooden eggs (available in Craft Dept.)
- Craft paint (non-glossy)
- Glitter
- Flocking

Directions:

1. Paint all wooden eggs in various colors (it may take a couple of coats). Let dry.
2. Apply various Glue Dots® and Glue Lines® around eggs to create desired patterns.
3. Gently roll eggs in glitter or flocking, removing any excess when finished.
4. Arrange eggs in a basket with grass to create a beautiful centerpiece!



Egg Cards

Supplies:

- 1" Glue Lines®
- Pink or Blue cardstock
- Ribbon
- Yellow cardstock
- Scissors

Directions:

1. Cut 1 egg shape out of yellow cardstock to create the card base.
2. Cut 2 more egg shapes about a 1/2" larger on each side out of pink or blue cardstock.
3. Take one of the larger egg shapes and apply Glue Lines® around outer edge.
4. Adhere matching egg shapes together, pressing firmly around the edges to secure the bond.
5. Cut a jagged line horizontally through the middle of the two eggs adhered together to create the envelope.
6. Secure ribbon with 1" Glue Lines®, layering ribbon to add depth.
7. Write a personal greeting on yellow egg, and slide into jagged opening to close the card.



Treat Holders

Supplies:

- 1" Glue Lines®
- Micro Glue Dots®
- Scissors
- XL Glue Dots®
- Craft Glue Dots®
- Crepe paper
- XXL Glue Dots®
- Pink cardstock
- Tissue paper
- Mini Glue Dots®
- Glitter
- Candy

Pocket Directions:

1. Cut a half circle out of pink cardstock.
2. Apply Glue Lines® along straight edge of one side of half circle.
3. Create a cone shape with the half circle and adhere the two straight ends together.
4. Flatten the cone to create a pie slice pocket.
5. Apply various Craft Glue Dots®, Mini Glue Dots® or Micro Glue Dots® in a desired pattern on pocket and cover in glitter.
6. Press glitter onto Glue Dots® for a secure bond.
7. Fill pocket with tissue paper and candy.

Flower Directions:

1. Peel off clear liner from the XXL or XL Glue Dots®.
2. Cut about 3' of crepe paper and fold in half lengthwise for use with an XXL Glue Dot. Use 1½' of crepe paper for an XL Glue Dot®.
3. Accordion fold the crepe paper to add texture.
4. While folded, cut scalloped edge along the outside edge of crepe paper.
5. Beginning in the center of the XXL Glue Dots®, adhere crepe paper to the XXL Glue Dots® in a spiral, moving outwards until it is covered.
6. Fluff crepe paper to your liking.
7. Peel remaining liner away from flower and attach to pocket.
