Supplies

- Assorted jewelry (beads, brooches, earrings, pendants, buttons, etc.)
- 6" Styrofoam™ ball
- Ruffled tulle trim
- Wire-edged satin ribbon
- 5/8"x 36" dowel rod
- Bridal pins
- Craft saw
- Double-sided adhesive
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Paint
- Plastic plate for paint
- Paintbrush
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- Pliers



1 Measure and mark dowel rod to 9".



2 Using a craft saw, cut dowel rod at mark. This will be the bouquet handle.



3 Paint Styrofoam™ ball desired color.



4 Carve a hole in Styrofoam™ ball to accommodate handle. Hole should be 3" deep and the diameter of the dowel rod. Place a dab of craft glue in hole.



5 Insert dowel rod into hole, and let dry.



6 Wrap ruffled tulle trim around handle.

Wrap wire-edge satin ribbon around handle to cover ruffled tulle trim, securing with double-sided adhesive.

Tie a bow to top of handle as shown.

Use bridal pins to secure ruffled tulle trim around base of Styrofoam™ ball.

Pin spirals of tulle trim to Styrofoam™ ball as shown. Place trim anywhere you want it to peek through the jewelry on the completed bouquet.

If desired, paint some of your pieces to add color to the bouquet.

Add jewelry to Styrofoam™ ball. Secure the larger pieces first, and then fill in with the smaller pieces.
