GRANNY SQUARE HAT

A cozy-wozy slouch hat with a funky retro color scheme and a granny square trim? That, ladies and gentlemen, is a hipster moment waiting to happen! Make one for yourself with a little help from our free crochet pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch – chain
Dc – double crochet
Dc2tog – double crochet together
Rep – repeat
Rnd(s) – round(s)
Sc – single crochet
Sl st – slip stitch
Sp – space
St(s) – stitch(es)

MATERIALS:

Yarn Bee® Andes Alpaca (shown in Peacock, Pearl, Dark Apricot and Cinnamon), 3.5 oz. skeins of 120 yds.



Color 1 (A) – 1 skein
Color 2 (B) – 1 skein
Color 3 (C) – 1 skein
Color 4 (D) – 1 skein
Yarn needle

CROCHET HOOK:

Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

2 rnds of main body = 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"



DIRECTIONS:

GRANNY SQUARE TRIM/BAND (Make 9)

Note: We made 4 squares using A and B, 2 squares using D and C, and 3 squares using B and D.

Ch 4, sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 2 dc into ring, ch 3, *3 dc into ring, ch 3. Rep from * 2 more times. Sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Using new color, sl st into any ch 3 sp. Ch 3, 2 dc into ch 3 sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same sp, ch 1, *3 dc into next ch 3 sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same sp, ch 1. Rep from * 2 more times. Sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends.

To form the band, sc sides of squares together using coordinating yarn.

BODY OF HAT

Note: Hat is worked from the top down.

Using A, ch 4, sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 11 dc in ring (12 dc total). Sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around (24 dc total). Sl st to join.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2 (48 dc total).

Rnd 4: Using D, ch 3, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next st, *2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 6: Using B, ch 3, 1 dc in next st and each st around. Sl st to join.

Rnds 7-11: Rep Rnd 6, alternating colors every 2 rnds, continuing with B, then C, then A.

Rnd 12: Using D, ch 3, *dc2tog, 1 dc in next st. Rep from * until 2 sts remain, dc2tog. Sl st to join.

Rnd 13: Ch 3, 1 dc, dc2tog, *1 dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 14: Using A, ch 1, 1 sc in each st around. Finish off and weave in ends.

BOTTOM EDGE

Using A, 1 sc in each st at bottom of granny square band. Finish off and weave in ends.

ASSEMBLY

With right sides of band and body of hat together, sew the top edge of band to the bottom of hat with yarn needle and coordinating yarn. Finish off and weave in ends.

SLOUCHY BERET

You'll be a cool customer when you paint the town in this warm and toasty slouch hat. The look gets its contemporary vibe from unfussy stripes and a trendy teal-on-white color palette. Ooh, we feel a crochet day coming on!

MATERIALS:

Yarn Bee® Andes Alpaca (shown in Peacock and Pearl), 3.5 oz. skeins of 120 yds.



Medium

Color 1 (A) – 1 skein

Color 2 (B) – 1 skein

Yarn needle

SIZE:

24" circumference at band

GAUGE:

2 rnds of main body = 2 ¼" x 2 ¼"

CROCHET HOOK:

Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge



DIRECTIONS:

BODY OF HAT

Note: Hat is worked from the top down.

With A, ch 4, sl st to form ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), 11 dc in ring (12 dc total). Sl st to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around (24 dc total). Sl st to join.

Rnd 3: Rep Rnd 2 (48 dc total). Sl st to join.

Rnd 4: With B, ch 3, 1 dc in same st, 1 dc in next st, *2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next st. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 4.

Rnd 6: With A, ch 3, 1 dc in next st and each st around. Sl st to join.

Rnds 7–13: Rep Rnd 6, alternating colors every 2 rnds.

Rnd 14: With A, ch 3, dc2tog, *1 dc in next st, dc2tog. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 15: Rep Rnd 14.

Rnd 16: With B, ch 2 (counts as 1 sc, ch 1), *1 sc, ch 1. Rep from * around. Sl st to join.

Rnd 17: 1 sc in each st. Finish off and weave in ends.

POMPOM

Cut 3" cardboard square. Wrap yarn around square until it is covered with five layers of yarn. Slip yarn off square and firmly tie a 12" piece around middle. Leave the tie ends long to attach the pom-pom. Cut loops at each end and trim to a 2" smooth ball. Using yarn needle, fasten pom-pom securely to top of hat.
