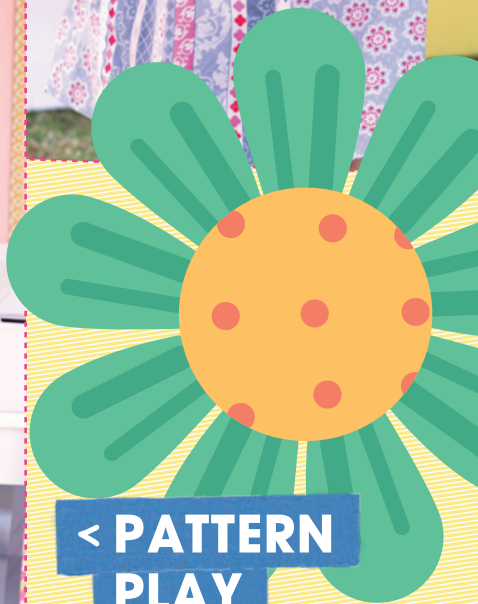
BABY IN BLOOM >
