How do you tailor off-the-shelf curtain panels to fit your current décor? It's ribbon to the rescue! Just pull out the wires, layer as desired, and stitch into place.



« SHADY LADY

We used two lengths of creamy, unembellished ribbon (sumptuously hand-gathered after removing the wire and hot glued) to go around the top and bottom portions of this formerly no-frills lampshade. Then we used a stunning beaded version to accent the middle.

* HAUTE COZY

Turn ordinary pillow covers into posh soft spots by stitching on a glitzy mix of embellished ribbons. Trim them, twist them or twirl them as desired—and stitch!

Tip: Don't want to sew? Many of the projects shown here can be made using fabric glue. Easy-peasy!







*IN FRAME


Glam up a stately frame using our richly embellished ribbon. Just place behind the glass for display.

*FAB FRILLS

Knick-knackery: ribbon-embellished frame, ribbon-covered foam spheres, ribbon table runner. Tip: For the table runner, we used fusable ironon to adhere three strands of ribbon together.











TRÈS TABLE

Try a hint of shimmer in a mad-about-mod space by trimming away the sides of embellished wired-edge ribbon.

1. Pleat ribbon (with wire removed) and attach to frame using a staple gun. Then staple on embellished portion of ribbon—the staples blend right in!

2. Stitch ultra-glam ribbon down sides of an off-the-shelf table runner.

3. Spray paint two antlers, glue together, and wrap ribbon around middle.
