1. PHOTO OP

You won't find anything as personal as this off-the-shelf photograph suspended in vegetable oil. And thanks to our easy-to-use kit—it's a lamp too! We sponged on some black paint to age the lamp kit a little, and we finished off the look with a simple black shade.

2. LIKE A CHARM

How to hang jingles, jangles and all kinds of pretty little dangles from your jar? Outfit your trinkets with jump rings, and slide them onto some jewelry wire. Wrap the wire tightly around the lid—and you're good! Jar color and texture: acrylic paint and embossing powder.

3. OLD TRICKS

Try this for a got-it-at-an-antique-store finish: tan acrylic paint, followed by blue acrylic paint. When the project is completely dry, you can use a craft knife to scrape away portions of the top layer of paint to mimic peeling. *Tip: We dry-brushed a bit of brown over the blue for a hint of extra age.*

IMPORTANT:

- Do not cover the vent holes.
- Do not place anything that weighs over 1 lb. inside mason jar.
- Use maximum 25 watt light bulbs.

Standing Lamp Kits

- Use maximum 40 watt light bulbs.

HANG IN THERE

4. Cup chain trim, white spray paint, and lace used as a stencil.
5. Twine, wrapped around the lid and the cord.
6. Glass glitter and burlap trim.
