


bright albums

These bright, beautiful albums will make you smile long before you open the covers. Decorated with our vivid papers, they're eye-catching additions to a prominent shelf or a lighthearted coffee table. To make your own, measure paper to fit a blank album of your choice (or select an album that already features our 'Happy All Over' designs and simply embellish further.) Then, use doublesided adhesive to secure the paper to the cover. Finally, add an assortment of cheerful embellishments-we used alitter, buttons, rhinestone buckles, chipboard letters, coordinating ribbons, and even 3-dimensional flowers that were cut from scrapbook paper.




Our petite dress form is just too cute, and you can get the same look in no time! First, make a simple vest pattern using scrapbook paper—it's your own design! For the skirt, simply measure for length and width. Then, fold the desired amount of patterned paper into pleats, securing the pleats with double-sided adhesive as needed. Finally, wrap the pleated paper skirt around the form's waist. Close the paper with double-sided adhesive and finish with a cute coordinating ribbon sash... tied in a fun-loving bow!



charming mirror

Check your smile in a mirror that's positively charming! Using a blank wood mirror (available in the craft dept.) as a base, trace the shape onto our cheery scrapbook paper. Next, cut out the design and use double-sided adhesive to carefully adhere the paper to the surface of the wood. Embellish the piece with 3-D stickers and puffy alphabet stickers for a finished project that pairs function with loads of super-smiley fun!

The shades say it all! Our vibrant scrapbook page is just too cool to hide in an album. For this look, we paired solid cardstock with a joyful collection of patterned scrapbook papers. We cut out circles with a scalloped paper punch, and we layered them with 3-D stickers, brads, and buttons. We added a cute-as-can be photo, and we finished with a super-happy title spelled out with bold chipboard stickers.






playful frames

These festive framed couture silhouettes are just a few snips away. You can look to scrapbook paper, stencils, magazines or even clip art for the perfect silhouette. Then, trace the art onto patterned paper (it's fun to mix and match papers on the same design—just piece them together like a puzzle). Next, embellish the designs with wire, buttons, and matching ribbon. Finally, use double-sided adhesive to secure the silhouettes to cardstock or scrapbook paper. Display the pieces in coordinating frames, and you've got boutique-style art with a purely fashionable appeal.

cheery lamp

This happy lamp is covered to coordinate with the cheery console table. It's as pretty as a picture, and a snap to recreate using a self-adhesive shade kit (available in the Sewing Notion Dept.). Cover the shade with a fun striped paper, then trim the shade with matching ribbons. Finally, cut flowers from coordinating paper and embellish with ribbon-covered buttons. Hot glue flowers to the shade, as desired.





Happiness can hop from a lamp to a letter in your cheery little nook. To create, paint a paper-maché letter with a solid coat of acrylic paint. Then, apply scrapbook paper with double-sided adhesive (you'll need to trace and cut the paper to fit each letter.) Next, cut flowers from coordinating paper and embellish each flower with glitter; attach flowers with 3-D adhesive dots. Finish the project with a sweet little word sticker.

whimsy little tassel

It looks like fabric from afar, but this whimsical tassel is actually made of paper! To make your own, cut fun printed paper to the desired length. Cut the paper into strips, leaving approximately ½" uncut at the top. Then, carefully fold top of paper 2-3 times for fullness. Next, wrap the folded paper into a cylinder, and secure it with a dot of hot glue. Finally, use paper or coordinating ribbon to create a hanger. Attach the hanger to either side of the tassel, and hide the ends with a strip of scrapbook paper as shown.
