Jewelry Findings

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Follow manufacturer's instructions in using paints and other materials keeping them out of the reach of children, since some may be toxic, or otherwise cause injury.

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LETTER IMPRINTING

Front page project step by steps



STEP 1
Use a metal working, or leather working letter stamp set to imprint words. Place the first letter onto the blank.



STEP 2
Using a small jeweler's hammer, individually hit the letters into the blank with approximately 3 solid taps.



STEP 3
Use either a polishing cloth or a small amount of metal polish to relief around the letters and accentuate the word.

TIP: Use chain nose pliers to flatten the blank if the corners turn or if it is warped from hammering.

Try layering blanks of various shapes and sizes to create dimensional designs.

Altered Collage

Use decorative papers to create a unique altered collage. Accent with fire polished Czech glass and crystal.



STEP 1
Cut or punch out paper to fit your desired blank's shape and size. Use Glossy Accents™ to glue the paper to the blank and apply a protective coating.



STEP 2
Starting at one corner, apply an even thick layer over the paper, working your way across the entire surface. Take care to make sure hole in blank is clear. Let dry for 24 hours before handling. (To ensure the best results, follow the manufacturer's instructions.)



Try this technique with a variety of different mediums...embossing powders, alcohol inks, rub-ons, stickers and more!
