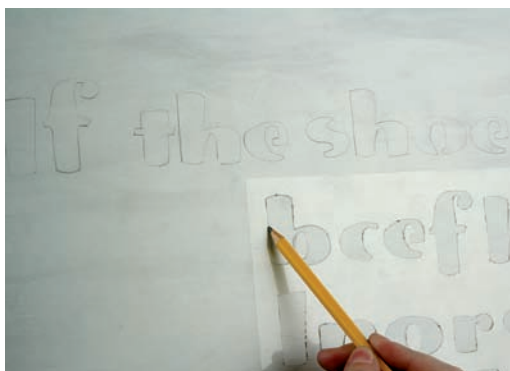

How to make a custom stencil...

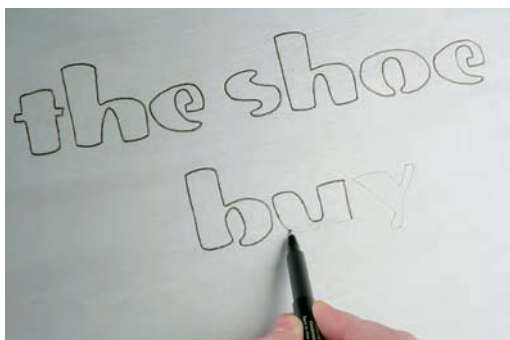
Supplies: Blank Stencil Sheet, Alphabet Stencil, Black Pen, Craft Knife, Cutting Mat, Pencil, Paintbrushes, Black Acrylic Paint

1. Use a copier to enlarge stencil to 200%. Then, place a blank stencil sheet over the image, and trace the letters directly onto the sheet.



2. Using craft knife, carefully cut around the traced letters. Now you've got a custom wall stencil!

3. Place your newly-made stencil on wall, or any desired surface, and trace with pencil. (We couldn't stop at the wall...we made stencils for paper-maché boxes, a wooden cabinet, even a dress form!)



4. When you're satisfied with the placement of the letters, go over the pencil tracing with a black pen.

5. Fill in the letters with acrylic craft paint to complete your custom stencil.
