

shadow box

SUPPLIES

Unfinished Wood Box • Scrapbook Paper Chipboard Hearts • Alphabet Stickers • Buttons Cardstock • Embroidery Floss • Ribbon • Chipboard Wood Knobs • Acrylic Paint • Decoupage Glue Paint Brush • 3-D Foam Adhesive • Hole Punch

- 1. Paint wood box. Once dry, use decoupage glue to adhere scrapbook paper the box covering inside and outside the box.
- 2. Double matte a photo with scapbook paper and cardstock. Adhere to inside the box.
- Use alphabet stickers to spell out a quote, name, or words onto cardstock and cut out each word. Adhere the box with 3D foam adhesive for added dimension.
- 4. From chipboard, cut out a roof and cover with paper. Adhere to the top edge of the box.
- 5. Embellish the house: Cut out a picket fence from cardstock and adhere to the bottom edge of the box. Paint one chipboard heart and cover a second heart with paper. Punch a hole in each heart with a hole punch and hang from the roof's corner. Add threaded buttons to the roof and to one heart.
- 6. Paint knobs and adhere to the bottom of the box as legs.

tags & cards

Use acetate to show your true creative style!
These "clearly" fun tags and cards are merely paper crafts sandwiched between acetate for a whimsical look. Round party favor tins become instant funky display stands by punching a hole through the plastic lid and putting flexible wire into each hole. Form the top into a sprial to hold your creations.

paper flowers


SUPPLIES

Scrapbook Paper • Cardstock Shaped Paper Punches • Dowels Acrylic Paint • Adhesive • Hot Glue

- Cut a strip of scrapbook paper 3" wide x 12" long and accordion fold the width in ¼ inch increments.
- 2. Make the flower by adhering the two ends of the folded paper together, creating a full circle
- 3. Use different shaped punches to create cardstock centers for each flower.
- 4. Paint dowel with acrylic paint. When dry, adhere to the back side of each flower.

dream album

We dressed up this store bought album by cutting out a square from the cover with a craft knife and decorating with paper, ribbons and an epoxy sticker quote.





scrapbook page (cover)

SUPPLIES

Scrapbook Paper • Cardstock
Acetate • 3D Foam Adhesive Shapes
Paper Adhesive • Craft Knife • Sewing Machine

- Cut a strip of scrapbook paper 3" x 12". Use a craft knife to to cut out various parts of the design and adhere acetate to the back side, creating a window effect.
- 2. Adhere a photo to the 12x12 cardstock, placing it off center. Use sewing machine to stitch all the way around the photo, adding interest.
- 3. Next sew different types of stitches to the right of the photo, the full length of the cardstock.
- 4. Place 3D foam adhesive dots to the back side of the acetate and pattern paper strip, then attach to the cardstock letting the stitches peek through the window openings.
- 5. Embellish the rest of the layout with printed words and paper strips.




Layer, layer, layer! Tags can dress up and say it all, just like this fun memento tag that is actually two tags in one. One is a circle-punched cardstock and patterned paper, and the second is bold alphabet stickers that help label the suitcase.

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accordion album

SUPPLIES

Chipboard • Scrapbook Paper Cardstock • Ribbon • Buttons Alphabet and Number Stickers Pencil • Embroidery Thread



- 1. Design, trace and cut 8 house shapes out of chipboard.
- 2. Lay 4 chipboard houses side by side, leaving ½ inch space between each one. Measure the length across the four houses, and cut 2 pieces of ribbon slightly shorter than this length. Lay the two ribbons across the four houses.
- Adhere a chipboard house shape onto the top of the existing house shapes, sandwiching the ribbon in between.
- 4. Decorate each house with cardstock, scrapbook paper, photos, buttons and stickers. You can even decorate the back sides of the houses completely different, creating a reversible album!

candle cover

The fastest way to bring style and color to an everyday candle is to give it a wrap. Simply cut scrapbook paper to size and wrap around candle securing the paper with double-sided adhesive on the back side. The brads are then pushed into the candle and offer a punch of color for minimal effort.
