Step 1 Cover metal board with damask patterned cardstock. Ink edges. Cut blocks of black and white cardstock. Ink edges and adhere to board as shown.



Step 2 Cut . Using black cardstock, select Phrase feature and cut one 2 1/2" < Door>. Adhere to board as

Step 3 Cut clock. Using white cardstock, cut one 3" <Clock2>. Repeat cut using black cardstock. Ink edges. Layer together. Cover inside of clock with liquid glass. Let dry overnight. Adhere to board as shown using foam squares.

Step 4 Adhere chain to board as shown. Attach ribbon to top of board to create a hanger.

glue gun on center and

- ☐ Cuttlebug® A2 Embossing Folder,

- ☐ Tulle: white
- ☐ Metal flower embellishment
- ☐ 1 ¼" Circle punch
- ☐ Paper trimmer
- ☐ Hot glue gun

Instructions

Step 1 Cut cake box. Using the Sweet Tooth Boxes cartridge and blue check cardstock, cut one 11" <Cake>. Using pink with words cardstock, cut one 11" <CakeLy1>. Using pink floral cardstock, cut one 11" <CakeLy3>. Using pink cardstock, cut one 11" <CakeLy2>.

Emboss pink strips using Cuttlebug® machine and Swiss Dots folder. Assemble box as shown.

Step 2 Cut tag. Using yellow check cardstock, select **Real Dial Size** and cut one 1 ¾" <TrngLy4>. Using pink with words cardstock, select **Real Dial Size** and cut one 1" <CakeLy4>. Layer together.

Step 3 Cut two 1" strips of yellow checked cardstock. Fold in ½" increments. Use hot glue gun to adhere strips together to form a pleated circle.

Step 4 Punch a circle from pink cardstock. Emboss using Cuttlebug® machine and Swiss Dots folder. Adhere to center of pleated circle. Attach flower embellishment.

Step 5 Cut one 7" x 12" strip of tulle. Fold in half. Use hot glue gun to adhere behind pleated circle. Adhere pleated circle and tag to cake box as shown.
