Supplies: Silk Flowers, Bouquet Holder, Bouquet Collar, Wired Ribbon, Floral Tape, Floral Pick Machine or Handy Pick™(not pictured), Steel Picks, Cutting Pliers, Scissors



1. Trim stems to about 3" in length. Secure steel picks to the stem with either a floral pick machine as shown in picture or with a Handy Pick™.



2. Wrap green floral tape around the stems to hide steel picks and ensure that the picks stay in foam.



3. Place the bouquet holder into the collar, and begin inserting stems into foam, working around the edge of collar.



4. Slowly continue working towards center of bouquet, as pictured.



5. Use white floral tape to secure the bouquet holder to the bouquet collar.



6. Form three loops of ribbon and secure with floral pick and tape. Insert loops into foam.
