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#### SIMPLE

#### SUPPLIES

- 2 Skeins Yarn Bee™ First Love Yarn (shown in Misty)
- L-8.00mm hook
- Tapestry Needle

#### GAUGE:

4" x 4" = 7 rows of 9 hdc

APPROXIMATE MEASUREMENTS: 40" long, 6" wide

## STITCHES USED:

chain (ch) stitch (st) slip stitch (sl st) single crochet (sc) half double crochet (hdc) Back Loop (BL) Front Loop (FL) repeat (rep)

#### NOTES:

- 1. The numbers at the end of each row are the stitch count for the row. (#)
- 2. Chain stitches do not count in the stitch count.

#### COWL:

Row 1: ch 101, sc in 2nd ch from the hook and each ch across, ch2, turn (100)

Row 2: hdc in each st across, ch2, turn (100) Row 3: hdc in the BL of each st across, ch 2, turn (100)

**Row 4:** hdc in the 1st st, sl st in the next, \*(hdc in the next st st, sl st in the next st,)

Rep from \* across, ch 2, turn (100)

Row 5: hdc in each st across, ch2, turn (100)

Row 6: hdc in the FL of each st across, ch 2, turn (100)

Row 7: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (100)

**Row 8:** hdc in the 1st st, sl st in the next, \*(hdc in the next st st. sl st in the next st.)

Rep from \* across, ch 2, turn (100)

# MAKE THAT COWL, GIRL

Row 9: : hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (100) Row 10: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (100) Row 11: hdc in the BL of each st across, ch 2, turn (100) Row 12: hdc in the 1st st, sl st in the next, \*(hdc in the next st st, sl st in the next st) Rep from \* across, ch 2, turn (100) Row 13: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (100) Row 14: hdc in the FL of each st across, ch 1, turn (100) Row 15: sc in each st across, ch 1, do not turn, do not fasten off (100) \*Join Ends: With right sides together (textured sides) sc

evenly down the edge, fasten off and weave in ends.

## BELT:

Row 1: ch 16, hdc in the 3rd ch from the hook and each ch across, ch 2, turn (14) Row 2: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (14) Row 3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (14) Row 4: hdc in each st across, ch1, do not turn (14) Fasten off leaving a 10-12 inch tail to sew belt around cowl.

# FINISHING:

- Find cowl seam and gather it together.
- Wrap belt around cowl seam.
- Sew belt closed with tapestry needle using a whip stitch.
- Flip belt inside out to hide seam.
- Add a button or pin to the belt as desired.
