lo•vey /luhvee/: n. A small familiar object (usually something soft and snuggly) that comforts your little cuddler. It soothes, consoles and de-stresses. And if it's really special, your toddler will want to tote it around the clock.

General Instructions:

Both blankets are constructed of several pieces (see below) that must be sewn together following the photos as a guide:

Part 1: Head, ears, nose, mouth, eyes and flower/bow tie.

Part 2: Body of the blanket with contrasting circles.

Part 3: Legs and tail.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

Small Crochet Decrease (sc dec): Insert hook and draw up a loop in each of the next two small crochets (three loops now on hook), hook yarn and draw through all three loops on the hook. Single crochet decrease made.

beg = beginning

dc = double crochet

lps = loops

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

sp = space

st = stitch

rp = repeat

yo = yarn over

sc dec = small crochet decrease

rnd = round

Every bunny needs the perfect lovey. That means your precious one will be thrilled when you pull this project out of your hat.

SUPPLIES:



(50% acrylic, 50% cotton) in color Medium Naked #11, 1 skein (208 yards)



• Color C: Baby Bee®, Angel Fleece

(97% acrylic, 3% polyester) in color

Bulky Pink-A-Boo #36, 2 skeins (127 yards)

• Hook 1: Size F/5 (3.75mm) to use with Hushabye Yarn

• Hook 2: Size I/9 (5.50mm) to use with Angel Fleece Yarn

Yarn Needle

• Poly-Fil®

CROCHET INSTRUCTIONS: Little Bunny

• HEAD (Make one). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4-6: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch. At the end of rnd 6, fasten off.

Rnd 7: Attach color C (Pink-A-Boo #36), Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 9-12: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, sc dec in next 2 sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in bea ch.

Rnd 15: Rep rnd 13. Stuff with Poly-fil® and continue to next rnd.

Rnd 16-17: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. At the end of rnd 17, close in circle, fasten off and weave in ends (will attach head to blanket in later step).

• EARS (Make two). With color A (Naked #11), ch 21. Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hook, and sc in every ch across until only one ch is left, do not turn, 5 sc in last ch. Working across opposite side of the foundation ch, sc in every ch across until the end of the rnd. Turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in next 20 sc, *[2 sc in next sc], rep * three more times, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in next 22 sc, *[2 sc in next sc], rep * three more times, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, fasten off.

Rnd 5: Attach color C (Pink-A-Boo #36). Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, skip sc], rep * ten times, sc in next 8 sc, and rep * until only one sc is left in the rnd, sc in last sc, turn.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, fasten off and weave in ends. Sew ears onto head (see photo) using the color C.

• NOSE/MOUTH Using color A (Naked #11), ch 10. Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc across until one 1 ch is left, do not turn, 5 sc in last ch. We will continue working sc in the opposite side of the foundation ch to create an oval, with sc in every ch until only 1 ch is left, 5 sc in last ch, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3-6: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 7-8: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, sc dec in next 2 sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. Stuff with Poly-fil® and continue to next rnd.

Rnd 9-10: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch, close the oval ball, fasten off and weave in ends. For the nose, stitch a little dot on top of the oval mouth piece (see photo) using color B (Chocolate #80). For the mouth, stitch in the lines (see picture) under the nose using color B (Chocolate #80).

• EYES (Make two). With color B (Chocolate #80), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in circle, sl st in beg ch. Fasten off and weave in ends. Stitch the eves on (add evelashes for a girly look) using color B (Chocolate #80). Stitch a dot in the middle of the eyes using color A (Naked #11).

• FLOWER (Make one). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, sl st in beg ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *[5 dc in next sc, sc in next sc], rep * to create a total of 5 petals, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Working behind rnd 2, ch 1, *[ch 3, sc in the back of sc from previous rnd], rep * across to create a total of five 3-ch lps, sl st in beg ch. Fasten off and weave in end.

Rnd 4: Attach color B (Chocolate #80). Ch 1, *[7 dcs in next 3-ch lp, sc in front of next sc from previous rnd], rep * to create a total of 5 petals, sl st in beg ch. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew flower to ear (see photo) using color A (Naked #11).

CROCHET INSTRUCTIONS CONT: Little Bunny,

• **BLANKET BODY** (Make one). With color C (Pink-A-Boo #36), ch 31.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hook and sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 3-26: Rep rnd 2. At the end of rnd 26, fasten off and weave in ends. Sew head onto blanket (see photo) using color C (Pink-A-Boo #36).

Create a border all around the square using a different yarn. Attach color A (Naked #11).

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in every sc across the perimeter of the blanket (4 sides), sl st in beg ch to close rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1 sc in every sc across the whole perimeter of the blanket (4 sides). In the corners, work 3 sc in same sc for a more square look, sl st in beg ch to close rnd.

Rnd 3: Rep rnd 2. At the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch, fasten off and weave in ends. Sew head onto blanket (see photo) using color C (Pink-A-Boo #36).

• CIRCLES (Make 3 in 3 different sizes).

For the big circle, follow instructions below. For medium circle, repeat rnds 1-5. For small circle, repeat rnds 1-3.

BIG CIRCLE: With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 6: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 7: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 8: Rep rnd 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Place the circles randomly on the blanket body (see photo for suggestion) and sew them on using the color A (Naked #11). • **LEGS** (Make 4). With color B (Chocolate #80), ch 4, sl st in beg to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *[sc in sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Attach color A (Naked #11). Ch 1, sc in sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4-10: Rep rnd 3. At the end of rnd 5, fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 11: Stuff the leg with Poly-fil® and close it together by flattening the filled tube and working a sl st to join both sides together. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew legs onto blanket (see photo) using color A (Naked #11).

• TAIL (Make one). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4: Rep rnd 2.

Rnd 5-7: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 8-9: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, sc dec in next 2 sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. Stuff with Poly-fil*.

Rnd 10-12: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. At the end of rnd 12, close in circle, fasten off and weave in ends.

Sew tail onto the blanket (see photo) using the color A (Naked #11).





The Lamb Plan

Mary had a little lamb...made of cuddly Baby Bee® yarn! Crochet your little one this snuggle-worthy project.

SUPPLIES:



• Color A: Baby Bee®, Hushabye Solid (50% acrylic, 50% cotton) in color Naked #11, 1 skein (208 yards)



• Color B: Baby Bee®, Hushabye Solid (50% acrylic, 50% cotton) in color Chocolate #80, 1 skein (208 yards)



• Color C: Baby Bee®, Angel Fleece (97% acrylic, 3% polyester) in color Mint Charm #26, 1 skein (127 yards)

- Hook 1: Size F/5 (3.75mm) to use with Hushabye Yarn
- Hook 2: Size I/9 (5.50mm) to use with Angel Fleece Yarn
- Yarn Needle
- Poly-Fil®



CROCHET INSTRUCTIONS: Little Lamb

• HEAD (Make one). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc every sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in bea ch.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 6: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 7: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 8: Rep rnd 4. Fasten off color A.

Rnd 9: Attach color C (Mint Charm #26). Ch 1, *[skip sc, sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sI st in beg ch.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 11-14: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch. Stuff with Poly-fil® and continue to next rnd.

Rnd 15-18: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beach. At the end of rnd 18, close in circle, fasten off and weave in ends (will attach head to blanket in later step).

• EARS (Make two). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4 and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, do not join the rnd, turn. Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc every sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3-4: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. Rnd 5-7: Rep rnd 2. At the end of rnd 7, fasten off. Fold the semi-circles in half and sew them to the head following the picture.

• NOSE (Make one). Using color B (Chocolate #80), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2-3: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. Stuff with Poly-fil®.

Rnd 4-5: Ch 1, sc dec in next 2 sc across until the end of the rnd, sI st in beg ch. At the end of rnd 5, close in circle, fasten off and weave in ends. Stitch the nose onto the face (see photo).

- EYES/MOUTH (Make two). Stitch the eyes and mouth using color B (Chocolate #80) (see photo).
- BOW (Make one). With color B (Chocolate #80), ch 50, sl st in beg ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in every ch across until the end of the rnd, sI st in beg ch.

Rnd 2-8: Ch 1, sc every sc across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 9: Attach color A (Naked #11), and rep rnd 2, fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 10: Attach color A (Naked #11) in the opposite side of the foundation ch, to create a matching border similar to rnd 9. Ch 1 and rep rnd 2, fasten off and weave in ends. Fold the tube in half to form a bow and stitch it in the middle to keep it in place. Now, create the center piece of the bow. Ch 15 and turn.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in every ch across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 2-4: Ch 1, sc every sc across until the end of the rnd. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Stitch the center piece of the bow in place, and then sew entire bow onto the blanket, under the lamb's head (see photo).

• BLANKET BODY (Make one). With color C (Mint Charm #26), ch 31.

Rnd 1: Sc in second ch from hook and sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in every sc across until the end of the rnd, turn.

Rnd 3-26: Rep rnd 2. At the end of rnd 26, fasten off and weave in ends.

Create a border all around the square using a different yarn. Attach color A (Naked #11).

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in every sc across the whole perimeter of the blanket (4 sides), sl st in beg ch to close rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 1 sc in every sc across the whole perimeter of the blanket (4 sides). In the corners, work 3 sc in same sc for a more square look, sl st in beg ch to close rnd.

Rnd 3: Rep rnd 2. At the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch. fasten off and weave in ends. Sew head onto blanket (see photo) using color C.

CROCHET INSTRUCTIONS CONT: Little Lamb

• CIRCLES (Make 3 in 3 different sizes).

For the big circle, follow instructions below. For medium circle, repeat rnds 1-5. For small circle, repeat rnds 1-3.

BIG CIRCLE: With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *[sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * across until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 5: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 6: Rep rnd 4.

Rnd 7: Rep rnd 3.

Rnd 8: Rep rnd 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Place the circles randomly on the blanket body (see photo for suggestion) and sew them on using color A (Naked #11).

• LEGS (Make 4). With color B (Chocolate #80), ch 4, sl st in beg to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *[sc in sc, 2 sc in next sc], rep * until the end of the rnd, sl st in beg ch.

Rnd 3: Attach color A (Naked #11). Ch 1, sc in sc across until the end of the rnd, sI st in beg ch.

Rnd 4-12: Rep rnd 3. At the end of rnd 5, fasten off and weave in ends.

Rnd 13: Stuff the legs with Poly-fil® and close by flattening the filled tube and working a sl st to join both sides together. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew legs onto blanket (see photo) using color A (Naked #11).

• TAIL (Make one). With color A (Naked #11), ch 4, and close circle to form a ring. Rnd 1: Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in beg ch. Rnd 2-20: Ch 1, sc in every sc across, sl st in beg ch. Rnd 21: Stuff the tail with Poly-fil® and close by flattening the filled tube and working a sl st to join both sides together. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew tail onto the blanket (see photo) using color A (Naked #11).
