There's no sewing necessary for these quirky bookmarks. Attach your Shrinky Dink® charm to a three-strand clasp before notching a tiny hole in the ribbon. Poke the clasp through the hole, fold back the ribbon and secure with hot glue. Done!

Want to add some hip to a handmade card? Create dimension and style with Shrinky Dinks®! Simply draw your design—just keep in mind that the image will shrink when baked. Then cut it out, bake it up and adhere it to your cardstock.

≈ **at a clip**

A clip for everything... and everything on its clip! These objects of organization feature elegant Shrinky Dink® labels. We cut them out before embellishing them with a permanent marker. After baking, we stamped on the lettering and decouped on some ephemera-style printed paper. Beautiful!

### flag flying »

A pennant banner on a plain Jane pillow? Why not? Trace a favorite font onto Shrinky Dink® plastic, and cut out the letters before baking, following the manufacturer's instructions. Then, use an eyelet punch to add a hole. . . and quick-stitch to secure!

### leave a mark »

Are we reading you right? You love a good. . . bookmark! Shrink your way to a sweetie-pie collection of accessories, all designed for keeping your place. You'll need the basics, along with ribbon and simple jewelry findings.

### on a chain ≡

Here's a Shrinky Dink® look that's bound to hang around. The backpack charm was created with a permanent marker and a collection of vivid colored pencils. We used an ordinary hole punch on the piece before popping it into the oven. Done!



### think shrink

How many ways can you wear a Shrinky Dink®? Let's count them on our fingers! Draw some delicious designs—use pencils, markers or paint, according to the color intensity you desire. Then cut out, bake and adhere to ring bases.

### charmed life

The jewelry just goes on and on! Create one-of-a-kind charms, perfect for a necklace or a jingly charm bracelet. Or put your shrinking skills to work on a pair of petite flower earrings. Simply follow the manufacturer's instructions to decorate, cut and bake!
