bow it... What better way to top a cute crayon wreath than a paper bow! This one features red ribbon layered with patterned paper and textured cardstock. The alphabet block embellishment is available in the craft department and is simply glued in place.

“P” stands for “perfectly sweet” when it comes to this one-of-a-kind monogram wreath. The letter was cut from sturdy foam board. We used hot glue to adhere crayons and wooden embellishments. Quick, simple and so much fun!

What's new at the zoo? Whimsical wooden animals and row after row of bright, colorful crayons! Crayons and adornments were mounted on a simple square frame (a bare wood piece we painted with a coordinating acrylic paint). **Tip:** These adorable zoo animals came pre-painted, and can go straight from package to project!



« blast off!...

Embroidery hoops made the perfect base for this spacy little accent. We applied crayons and ready-to-go, space-themed, wooden embellishments with hot glue. And the coordinating ribbon hanger? It was glued in place and reinforced with staples. This design is ready for lift off!



ocean notion

A project you can dive into? We have just the thing! This trio of seaside wreaths is built on petite embroidery hoops—each wreath uses two. We mounted colorful crayons, wooden embellishments and boldly-painted seashells with hot glue. Then we tied the hoops together with cording, as shown.
