## butterfly wreath

## SUPPLIES

Wire Wreath Form • Scrapbook Paper Cardstock • Rhinestones • Ribbon Craft Glue • Clear Thread • Hot Glue

This whimsical and imaginative wreath was fun to make. By hanging it on our mirror it became an instant focal point.

1. To create visual weight, simply adhere scrapbook paper to cardstock and cut out butterflies.
2. Using hot glue, adhere them to the wreath form in layers as pictured. For added support, tie a length of clear thread to wreath form and wrap thread around alternating butterflies.
3. Glam-up your butterfly wings by adding sparkling rhinestones using craft glue.
4. Create a dramatic sash for your wreath using wide ribbon. Adding large rhinestones with craft glue to the top of the sash also adds more sparkle and shine.

## candles



Candles are always great accents that with little effort can be transformed into trendy and stylish groupings. By simply adhering patterned paper, gorgeous ribbons and sparkling rhinestones you can make ordinary candles truly dazzle.


## plates

SUPPLIES
Glass Plates
Scrapbook Paper • Gold Paint Pen Decoupage Glue • Foam Brush • Pencil

Creating gorgeous, one-of-a-kind dinnerware that's sure to be the talk of the party is an easy project to dish up. Add a plate hanger and you have designer-style wall décor that's really storage incognito!

1. Begin by tracing your plate onto the backside of your scrapbook paper with a pencil. Cut out the shape.
2. Use a foam brush to apply a generous amount of decoupage glue to the backside of your plate. Next, apply a second generous amount of decoupage glue to the front of the scrapbook paper. Apply paper to glass, using fingertips to remove wrinkles and air bubbles.
3. Once dry, use a gold paint marker to run along the plate edges for a finished look.

Just a little reminder... these gorgeous plates are mostly decorative so a gentle hand-washing to only the plate fronts is recommended.



## napkin rings

The small details can bring big impact to a table top. These striking and shimmering napkin rings sure fit the part! Adhering rows of crystal rhinestones to ordinary store-bought napkin rings turned our rings from plain-jane to hip and trendy in no time flat.

# butterfly shadow box 

SUPPLIES<br>Shadow Box • Scrapbook Paper<br>Cardstock • Rhinestones • Acrylic Paint Double-Sided Adhesive $\bullet$ Craft Glue • Foam Brush

We couldn't just let these butterflies fly away, so we captured them in charming shadow boxes for pretty and surprisingly simple wall décor.

1. Begin by painting your shadow box black and set aside. Once dry, brush gold paint on various places over the black for an aged effect.
2. Trim and adhere scrapbook paper for your background as well as the inside edges of shadow box as pictured. Here's a tip: Mixing your scrapbook paper patterns adds visual dimension and is a great way to utilize leftover pieces.
3. Adhere cardstock to the back of your butterfly scrapbook paper for visual weight. Cut out three butterflies and attach to the inside of your shadow box using double-sided adhesive.
4. For added glitz, use craft glue to attach rhinestones down the center of each butterfly.


## collage shadow box
