Then, try your hand at a buttoned-up mirror (wooden plaque that's been painted and fitted with a pre-cut mirror). Or better yet, make your mark with a teeny-tiny button bouquet — stacked buttons, threaded with wire, hot glued to chenille stems and then inserted into the top of a wooden spool.
