Top Spot »

Jazz up a deskful of boring old pencils. It's fun to do with just a little foam! Cut a strip, fringe it, then roll it around the pencil, securing the end with craft foam adhesive. Done!



Get the Picture

Foam on canvas? What a colorful idea! For this look, cut a rectangle of foam to cover an 11x14" canvas. Then, use stencils, scrapbook paper or your imagination to help you trace and cut out a sunny scene. Use hot glue to hold it all in place!

That's what we say about this pretty stacked storage. They're paper maché boxes, entirely covered with colorful foam! We used a combination of hand-cut and pre-packaged flowers and polka dot pieces. Love it!
