A horse is a horse—unless it's displayed in a pretty little cloche jar. In that case, it's an objet d'art! This cloche comes without a base, so we improvised with a mirrored candle plate. We bordered the plate with leather trim to echo our equestrian theme.

**hear me roar** Dinosaurs are a little less scary when you've got them under glass. We made a platform for these mini monsters by gluing river rocks to a basic Styrofoam™ round. Then we altered the top of the cloche with acrylic paint, the base with a mixture of sand and decoupage medium, and added a coordinating ribbon. Bottom line: Don't be afraid to have a little fun and whimsy with our classic cloche jar.





## all grown up

Grow a teeny-tiny garden under glass! You'll find the little pots (they're fully functional) in the Floral Department, and you'll find the accessories near the dollhouse supplies. *Tip: If you don't have a green thumb, you can fake it with miniature faux plants, sold near the model train supplies.*
