« **Peace Please** Making peace is an easy task when it comes to this funky piece. The charm (you gotta love those colors) comes equipped with a lobster clasp. We simply removed and replaced it with a wide jump ring to accommodate a ready-to-go leather necklace cord.

» **Bloom Boom** This petal-pusher pendant is proof that flower power is alive and well! The colorful blossoms come linked as shown. All you have to do is decide how to wear them! We chose to suspend them from some simple black cording.



Wheel Good

This groovy little charm has room for vroom, and you don't have to do much to make it roadworthy. Try it solo on a simple chain. We went for a vibrant green ball chain—simple, affordable and fun!

Ear We Go

Let's do the dangle—with mini peace sign charms (they come six to a pack) and strands of lightweight rainbow chain. Attach it all to some simple hook ear wires and baby you're good to groove!





Cool Cat Fashion

So, what's the story on these adorable designs? Think swanky drive-ins, pink Cadillacs and hula hoops. That's right, baby! These playfully retro pieces are all about the '40s and '50s. They're vintage, they're fun, and we think they're flat out fabulous.



« **Thrice as Nice** Good things happen in threes... as you can see with this dainty floral pendant. To make it, you'll need our flower-topped bobby pins. Remove two blooms from their pins, and glue them to the remaining pin. Then slide the pin onto some simple cording.



« Like a Charm

What's the must-have bauble for the bobby soxer set? A well-appointed charm bracelet! Just choose a chain (browse the Jewelry Department for one that calls your name). Then fill it with pretties like our rose-colored drops, our pink flower charm and a selection of dainty beads.



Blue View

A little bit of blue goes a long way. That's easy to see when it comes to these exquisite flower cabochons. Inspired by the jewelry of the '40s, they're pretty enough to stand alone on a pair of post earrings, a simple ring base and a shiny silver chain.

Bowed Over

These dressy round drops are a dream! They're sold individually, and each one comes complete with a flirty gem-embellished bow. That means they were as easy as anything to turn into glamorous hook earrings.





So Rose

A rose drop pendant perched on a string of dainty pearls. That's all it took to tap into the sophisticated side of an era gone by. **Tip:** We wanted a delicate look for this piece, so we bypassed chunkier pre-strung necklaces. Instead, we chose small pearls and strung them ourselves.

Totally Rad

Got a thing for banana clips, rolled-up jeans and friendship bracelets? Well, put on your power suit, and try your hand at these easy-to-craft designs. We've got the components covered—think sharp shapes, bold patterns and pops of lace and chain. And they're all inspired by the 80's and 90's.



» Pattern Passion

You had the sweater. Larger than life flowers in a see-it-from-miles-away color scheme—and you wore it well! Now pare that quintessential '80s look down to a bright shell pendant hung from awesome rainbow chain. **Tip:** *Can't stop with just one righteous bauble? Try adding a single coordinating bead.*



» Go Bow

This radical mesh bow came attached to a hair band. We removed the band and replaced it with jewelry cording and purple leopard print beads. **Tip:** *Try adding a single coordinating bead.*



«Tight Tie

Try giving a nod to '80s fashion with a make-it-in-a-flash necklace! You can do it with a simple linked chain, a stylin' striped tie charm (sold in a rockin' three-pack) and a flashy blue heart charm. Hey, that look...like...totally rules!
