« save a seat

Place rented seats right with swathes of pretty satin—and hold the fabric in place with an altered frame. Remove the back from the frame, and replace it with a piece of dowel rod. Glue the rod across the back to mimic a buckle, and then paint the frame to coordinate with your decor.



» fishing for love

Here's the perfect catch for unique, spring-inspired centerpieces. Fill a large vase half-full with distilled water, and then liven it up with a pretty goldfish. Now, top with a semi-sphere of foam decked with springy floral stems, sparkly gemstone picks, and gorgeous crystal garlands. *Tip: For their safety and well-being, acclimate fish prior to event. Place fish in bag, lower bag into top of vase (use distilled water only) and let bag sit for 24 hours. We recommend no more than two fish per vase.*



captured beauty

Make your own mood lighting. You'll need a decorative birdcage (they come in white, but you can paint them to match your décor), hanging gems and a convenient battery-operated pillar candle.



» table treasures

Transform basic plastic tableware with strips of self-adhesive gems. The ones shown here come pre-connected, so it's a fast fix, and the results are instantly dramatic.



in the limelight

Every bride dreams of her day in the sun, and you'll have yours with splashes of contemporary color—try lime green for summer sizzle—and plenty of modern décor. You can cool things off with crisp white linens and clear tableware.



lime aid Let these juicy place card holders provide a trendy summertime twist for your reception tables. It's as easy as it looks—use a computer program you're familiar with to print the names. Then cut them out, and anchor them to lime halves with corsage pins. *Tip:* Cut off the pointed ends of the limes to keep them from rolling over.



« gem spin

Gem garlands give wedding-worthy shine to any off-the-shelf accent. They're simple, so they adapt to any style, but they don't overpower. We love the way they sparkle on this modern lighting.

» bright idea

We've got a bright idea! Transform a standard gift box into a personalized party favor with summery green ribbon and a sophisticated monogrammed envelope seal. Just tape the ribbon around the box and press on the self-adhesive letter.





cheers! It's easy to alter generic accessories to suit your wedding's seasonal theme. For example, turn our elegant glass flute and decanter sets into chic, summery table décor. Just add clear glass gems, self-adhesive gemstones and a sleek calla lily pick.



winter wedding-land

» name the day
