This lovey-dovey wreath is all paper-maché. The base is actually a hatbox lid, with the center cut out, creating a sturdy ring base. Then paper-maché heart boxes, lids and bottoms, were randomly hot glued to the base. Each box and lid was first embellished with acrylic paint, patterned paper and cute, coordinating stickers.





Yummy Storage

These hatboxes are yummy-all-over, thanks to a playful take on serving and storing. Decorated inside and out with acrylic paint and patterned paper, they're perfect for holding plates, napkins and utensils with whimsy. Then, when the bash is over, replace the lids and stack and store your party supplies in style.
