This season, try spelling out a message with painted and stained letters -it adds a rustic, personal touch to any fall display.

- Wooden letters
- Gold metallic paint
- Orange acrylic paint
- Walnut gel stain
- Paint cup
- Paintbrushes (3)
- Paper towels



Using a paintbrush, cover your letter with gold metallic paint. Let dry.

Use a clean brush to completely cover the letter with walnut gel stain. Do NOT let dry.

To achieve a distressed look, lightly dust orange paint onto letter with a stippling style. Apply more paint along edges, accenting corners and curves, as desired.

Tip: To achieve the look you see here, barely touch the wood with your brush as you make random, vertical strokes.



Using a paper towel, immediately wipe off walnut stain, leaving more stain on edges for depth of color.
